LESSON STYLES:

Traditional Method

Students learn to play the flute through technical exercises and pieces set by the teacher. They will develop music theory skills, aural and reading skills, and music history knowledge specific to the repertoire. If desired they can work towards AMEB or VCE exams. There are opportunities to perform solo and with others through the year.

The Suzuki Method

The Suzuki method is particularly effective for younger students. It is a unique and inspiring approach to music education developed by Dr Shinichi Suzuki. Dr Suzuki believed that musical ability is not an inborn talent but one that can be developed by creating a positive and enriched learning environment. It is based on the 'mother tongue' concept, whereby children learn music in the same way as they learn to speak their native language, through listening, imitation and the positive support of the parents. Parents are actively involved in the learning process by attending lessons and supporting home practice.

Group Class

Normally students will attend a group class once or twice a term. They will develop musical knowledge, aural skills and the ability to play in an ensemble.

ABOUT THE TEACHER:

Lisa is an approved Suzuki teacher who holds Grade 8 Flute and is currently studying a Diploma of Music at Melbourne University. In her final year at school she was dux of music, and also studied an extension music course at Monash University. Lisa is a member of the Cadenzato Quartet and has played a wide repertoire of classical, jazz and popular music for many audiences. She also plays flute and piccolo with the Cardinia Performing Arts Company and the Cardinia Concert Band.

Lisa has a flourishing private studio teaching flute and keyboard in group and private lessons.
