ABOUT THE LESSONS:

Gitta Green has been teaching music since 1982 and is a trained Suzuki teacher as well as traditional method, preparing for AMEB exams. Contact Gitta to discuss the best method for your needs.

Traditional Method

Students learn to play the violin/viola through technical exercises and pieces set by the teacher. They will develop music theory skills, aural and reading skills, and music history knowledge specific to the repertoire. If desired they can work towards AMEB or VCE exams. There are opportunities to perform solo and with others through the year.

The Suzuki Method

The Suzuki method is particularly effective for younger students. It is a unique and inspiring approach to music education developed by Dr Shinichi Suzuki. Dr Suzuki believed that musical ability is not an inborn talent but one that can be developed by creating a positive and enriched learning environment. It is based on the 'mother tongue' concept, whereby children learn music in the same way as they learn to speak their native language, through listening, imitation and the positive support of the parents. Parents are actively involved in the learning process by attending lessons and supporting home practice.

ABOUT THE TEACHER:

Gitta started learning violin at the age of 11, studied viola at the Bergish Conservatorium in Wuppertal, Germany and completed her Bachelor of Music Education in viola. After graduating she worked as a viola player with the Hamburg Symphony Orchestra for 6 years. Gitta migrated to Australia in 1978 where she studied with Keith Crellin and Richard Hornung in Adelaide. During the same period she Gitta qualified as a Suzuki teacher up to the intermediate level.

Gitta has taught both Suzuki and traditional method in Adelaide for the past 27yrs. She has played with the 'Belcanto, String Quartet' in numerous gigs around Adelaide over the last 18yrs also playing under John Hall and his Harmony Choir and gave recitals in the form of house concerts.

Gitta has recently moved to the Dandenong Ranges and has joined our team at the Ranges Music School.
